



FUN WITH SIGNAL FLAGS

Before the use of radios on ships, flags and pennants were used to communicate at sea. Each letter and number was represented by a colorful flag. These are called **signal flags!**

The messages from signal flags could be seen and read across long distances. Certain combinations of two flags had specific meanings, which were the same in many languages, and could be understood by sailors from different nations.

Check out the Nautical Flag Alphabet below!


