## **MOPC** Reservists Info

MOPC is a 12-week, stand-alone course that develops operational planners capable of performing in high-tempo, fluid maritime operational centers.

MOPC is open to SELRES Officers (O-3 to O-4) serving in planner billets for Numbered Fleet/Navy Component reserve unit. Although reservists are eligible to apply for open seats, priority is given to active component officers. Priority for reserve applicants will be given to junior most qualified officers who have the most tenure remaining in a Numbered Fleet/Navy Component reserve unit.

## **IMPORTANT TIMELINES TO CONSIDER**

- 90 days prior to your desired course start date, selected members will receive an email to confirm their availability for the course one last time. You will have two weeks to confirm your attendance before we move on to another SVM on our list.
- 65 days prior to the start of the class, selected members will receive an email confirming their enrollment in MOPC, with a validated requirement number for them to build and route their orders.

\*\*Your time to confirm is at the 90-day mark. If you end up dropping out of our course within the 65-day window prior to start date, you will be moved to the bottom of our waitlists moving forward.
