

For Select Reservist (SELRES) Applicants to MHSC

- The average acceptance rate for each MHSC offering is 20%.
- Seat priority is determined by Fleet MOC Reserve Enterprise Headquarters Units or their equivalents. Applicants are strongly encouraged to coordinate with their chain of command to advocate to their Fleet MOC HQ Leadership for seat assignment prioritization. Typically, the point of contact is the MOC HQ Unit's N7 or designated training rep.
- Due to high demand for seats, SELRES applicants not assigned to or slated to a Navy Reserve Fleet MOC support unit are unlikely to receive a quota.
- Reservist graduates qualify for 13 correspondence course points.
- MSOC Hybrid: The Naval War College has developed a path to allow MHSC graduates to continue to develop their skills by completing the more robust training objectives of the Maritime Staff Operators Course (MSOC). This Reserve-only program credits virtual MHSC program training, allowing students to enter a regularly scheduled MSOC in-residence class at week 3. The application for MSOC and MSOC Hybrid are combined into the same Form. If you're interested in MSOC Hybrid, simply apply for an MSOC offering after receiving confirmation of a MHSC seat. Hybrid graduates will receive the JOM AQD.
